## INTRODUCTION

---

### **REQUIREMENT BY LAW**

By virtue of the *Fire Services Act* all insurance companies, including the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia, are required to report to the Fire Commissioner **every** fire occurring in British Columbia in which it is interested as insurer. These reports may be filed directly or through the appointed adjuster. (There is NO minimum dollar value below which fires need not be reported).

This manual explains the correct way to complete the BC Insurance Fire Report form. Every endeavour has been made to make this form as easy as possible to complete. The coding structure has been reduced and simplified for the purpose of this combined insurance report. ### **DEFINITION OF A FIRE**

A fire is defined as any instance of destructive and uncontrolled burning, including, explosion of combustible materials.

The following examples are **not** considered fires:

- 1) a burned roast in the oven that causes smoke damage
- 2) discolouration caused by placing a hot metal on a kitchen counter
- 3) cigarette scar on a table or carpet.

## GUIDE TO COMPLETE INSURANCE REPORT FORM

Each section of the sample Insurance Report on Page 5 has been numbered for your convenience. Please refer to the following instructions to assist you in completing the form.

1. **Incident Number:** This reference number is essential. It consists of: (a) a code for the location where the fire occurred (b) the date (c) the first 2 digits of the time using the 24 hour clock and (d) an occurrence digit.

### Incident Number Details

**Location Code:** Use the Location Code Directory (located at the end of this manual) to get the proper code. To determine the location code of any place, you need to know whether or not the place is within a municipality (i.e. city, town, district, village). If it is, you would use the location code in Column A. If it is outside the municipal boundaries, you would use the location code in Column B, if there is fire protection, Column C if there is **no** fire protection.

**Date:** Enter the Year/Month/Day as specified in the 3 designated boxes.

**Hour:** This data is to be entered based on a 24hr clock. Do not record the minutes into this time, we are only concerned about the hour that the incident occurred. If the fire occurs at 10:30 a.m. (1030 hrs) put in '10' in the 2 spaces provided, if the fire occurs at 2:45 p.m. (1445 hrs), enter 14. If the time of fire is unknown, you may use '99' in the space.

**Occurrence:** The purpose of this space is to sequentially number multiple fires within the same location, date an hour. For the purpose of the Insurance Fire Report, you can leave this space blank unless you have been given the complete Incident Number by the fire department, in which case it may include a digit from 1 to 9 in this space.

2. **Select Incident Type:** Check off the type of fire that you are reporting. Your choices are: Structure, Vehicle, Outdoor, or Person.
3. **Location of Fire:** Indicates where the fire occurred. Give the full address of the location. In case of outdoor fires (e.g. vehicle), specify the location as best as you can.
4. **Postal Code:** Please fill in the Postal Code for the location of fire. It is very useful when we wish to narrow down locations to a certain part of a city or a small settlement in an unorganized area.
5. **Insured Status:** If your insured is the owner or owner/occupant, tick off the box next to the 'owner' if he/she is an occupant tick off the 'occupant' box. Do **not** tick off both boxes. Show given names in full, **not** just initials.
6. **Insured Information:** Provide name, company name (if applicable), address, date of birth and telephone number of insured.

7. **Spousal/Additional Names:** Provide full name of insured's spouse. Should the insured be a company, show full names of the principal officers. Continue in 'Remarks' section or on an additional sheet if more space is required.
8. **Loss:** Enter the Property Loss, Contents Loss, and Total Loss to the nearest dollar (no cents). Enter the amount you paid to the claimant, again, specifying Property Loss, Contents Loss, and Total Loss. Under Property Value at Risk, enter what the entire property is worth, whether or not the entire property was burned.
9. **Codes:** These lines **must** be filled in for all fires, fill in the blank spaces with the appropriate codes based on the codes reference provided below. If you cannot find an appropriate code, you may specify the information in words.

\*For the box marked 'Incident-IN', you enter 1 of 2 options. Enter 8000 if a fire department attended the fire, or 9000 if no fire department attended the fire.

10. **Occupants/Injuries/Fatalities:** How many people were occupying the property at the time of the fire? If you do not know, enter "unknown". Were there injuries? Fatalities? Enter the number of casualties as appropriate.
11. **Product/Equipment related to Ignition Source:** Provide any information on vehicle, appliance or equipment that was involved in the fire, especially if it was involved as an igniting object. This information is useful in identifying special problems with specific vehicles, appliances or equipment. If space is inadequate, continue your description in the "Remarks" box at the bottom of the form. Check off the "Confirmed Ignition Source" box or "Suspected Ignition Source" box when appropriate.
12. **Name of Mortgagee:** Do they have a loan or mortgage on the damaged property? Please list that information here.
13. **Name of Public Adjuster (if any):** Enter as appropriate. If none, then leave blank.
14. **Claims Adjuster:** List the Adjuster's information as requested.
15. **Remarks:** This provides you the opportunity to briefly describe the incident and to add any comments/clarification to any of the items you listed above.

**IMPORTANT** *\*Please make sure to record your name, title, telephone number, signature, and date at the bottom of the report.*

## CODES

---

### **ACT OR OMISSION - AO**

---

The human action or inaction that contributes to the fire cause or which caused the fire.

It is not only the Igniting Object, the Fuel or Energy in conjunction with it, or the Form of Heat, which result in a fire; there is also a set of circumstances precipitated by human acts (something is done) or human omissions (something which has not been done).

Code “0008 Act or Omission - Not Applicable” may be used where no specific indication of a deliberate or negligent human act or omission has been found. (e.g. lightning strike). When coding for Exposure fires, code as per originating fire, except where Urban-Wildland Interface coded as 9920.

---

Fuel or Energy denotes the fuel or energy used in conjunction with the Igniting Object

Notes: a) If lightning is involved, code under 7000.

b) In the case of an exposure fire, code under 8000.

*Example: If a fire results from gasoline being used to accelerate a coal fired stove, the fuel or energy used in conjunction with the stove (igniting object) is the coal and should be classified under 1000.*

1000 Solid fuel (e.g. coal, wood, pellets, paper or waste used for lighting or incidental burning)

2000 Fuel oil (includes diesel and kerosene)

3000 Gasoline

***Fuel Gases (4100 - 4400)***

4100 Fuel gas - natural gas

**IGNITING OBJECT – IG (Alphabetical)**

---

The Igniting Object is the actual equipment, device or item which brings about ignition. Sometimes referred to as "source of ignition."

If there is no Igniting Object, code under 1010. For example, if an electrical discharge from a transformer ignited the roof of a house, the igniting object would be the transformer, use code 5200. Alternatively, if an electrical discharge in the form of lightning ignited the roof of a house, there would be no igniting object and Code 1010 would apply.

- Notes:**
- a) *Igniting Object refers to the complete equipment and not to component parts.*
  - b) *In the case of an exposure fire, code under 8100 - 8900.*

**Note:** *When using the alphabetical listing, it is important to check numerical listing (behind) for complete description.*
