



Horse Racing Policy: Uncoupling of Entries (Standardbred)

All policies regarding this matter dated prior to the date on this document are void.

1. Horses that are normally coupled (owned by the same owner) may be uncoupled for wagering purposes in all Stake races when no more than 2 horses owned by the same owner have been entered.
2. Horses that are normally coupled, (owned by the same owner), should there be fewer than seven (7) separate betting interests (before uncoupling) entered in an open race or the highest claiming race of the race meet, may race uncoupled, but only if there are no more than two (2) entered to race.
3. Pursuant to section 1, when more than 2 horses owned by the same owner have been entered, specific approval from the Executive Director is required before uncoupling for wagering purposes only.
