tips: Don't leave anything in your vehicle • Be sure to watch the gate close each time you leave or enter secure parking areas • Look for a well-lit, open area, near pedestrian activity if you're parking outside • Keep an extra key with you, not in the vehicle • Never assume your vehicle won't attract a thief • Avoid the buildup of old insurance decals when applying new ones • Lock your vehicle • Invest in a good anti-theft device
